




WELCOME TO ARPD AQUATICS: MISSION STATEMENT





ADAPTIVE LESSONS:





Our Adaptive Aquatic Lessons offer a supportive environment for all abilities to learn swimming. Whether new to the water or improving skills, our certified instructors use specialized techniques to meet each participant's needs, ensuring a safe experience.

With a focus on water safety, confidence, and skill development, we customize lessons for various challenges, creating an inclusive space where everyone can enjoy swimming at their own pace.

SWIM LESSONS AGES

2 months-3 years old Star Babies

This course is designed to help children feel comfortable in the water while educating parents and caregivers on water safety and drowning prevention. It does not focus on teaching children to swim independently or survive in the water but instead provides a fun, supportive experience that builds confidence. Each child must be accompanied by an adult in the water.









3-6 years old Star Tots

This course builds confidence in the water and prepares children for swimming. It introduces functional swim skills through engaging and playful water activities for those who are developmentally ready. This level has no prerequisites, and students will be assessed on the first day. The program focuses on developing five core competencies, allowing each child to progress at their own pace in a supportive yet challenging environment.

STARFISH AQUATICS















Students develop five core swimming competencies and earn color stage awards for each achievement. These stages categorize students into broad ability groups, allowing them to progress at their own pace while learning core skills and advanced strokes.

Learning is self-paced yet challenging.

For Youth: Students focus on developing self-rescue swimming skills through appropriate activities, maintaining a self-paced and challenging environment.

For Teens and Adults: This course enhances comfort and skill in the water, regardless of prior experience, prioritizing functional self-rescue skills and adult learning principles.











STARFISH STROKE SCHOOL AQUATICS

AGES: 6-ADULT







This program is for students of all ages who have achieved the green Swim School benchmarks. Students learn stroke techniques for freestyle, elementary backstroke, sidestroke, backstroke, butterfly, and breaststroke and develop endurance and water fitness.

The Aquatic Intern Program is designed for youth (12-15 years old) interested in becoming lifeguards and Aquatic Instructors (AI) but still need to meet the minimum age requirements. This program will help prepare participants to apply for and work as professional lifeguards and AI once they meet the age requirement. All participants will help to protect the lives and well-being of each person using the pool and to teach swim lessons at our facilities.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be 12 15 years old
- Must have a 2.5 GPA or higher
- Be able to swim at a Red Cross Level 4 standard or above (pass the swim assessment test)
- Unofficial Transcript
- Letter of Recommendation(s):
- REQUIRED: ONE (1) recommendation from a personal (ex. parent, sibling, friend) or professional (ex. teacher, coach, office admin) reference
- A cover letter explaining the following:
- · Why you should be chosen for this program and
- What you hope to learn from this opportunity



























