APPROVING LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF ALAMEDA AND THE ALAMEDA FIRE CHIEFS ASSOCIATION TO CLARIFY RETENTION/LONGEVITY AND MANAGEMENT INCENTIVE PAY MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING LANGUAGE FOR CALPERS COMPENSATION COMPLIANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Alameda (the "City") is committed to ensuring compliance with CalPERS regulations concerning compensation for its employees; and

WHEREAS, CalPERS initiated a service retirement review for a Division Chief on January 25, 2024, which identified ambiguities in the Retention/Longevity Pay and Management Incentive Pay language within the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Alameda Fire Chiefs Association (AFCA); and

WHEREAS, the review found that the existing MOU language did not adequately describe the compounding nature of Retention/Longevity Pay, resulting in a reduction of final compensation calculations; and

WHEREAS, the Management Incentive Pay did not meet the California Code of Regulations requirements, leading to its exclusion from final compensation; and

WHEREAS, the City, in collaboration with CalPERS and AFCA, has drafted a Letter of Understanding to clarify the provisions of the MOU concerning Retention/Longevity Pay and Management Incentive Pay; and

WHEREAS, formal adoption of this updated language is required to request a new final compensation review for the Division Chief under the clarified provisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Alameda hereby approves the Letter of Understanding between the City of Alameda and the Alameda Fire Chiefs Association to clarify Retention/Longevity Pay and Management Incentive Pay MOU language for CalPERS compensation compliance. *****
