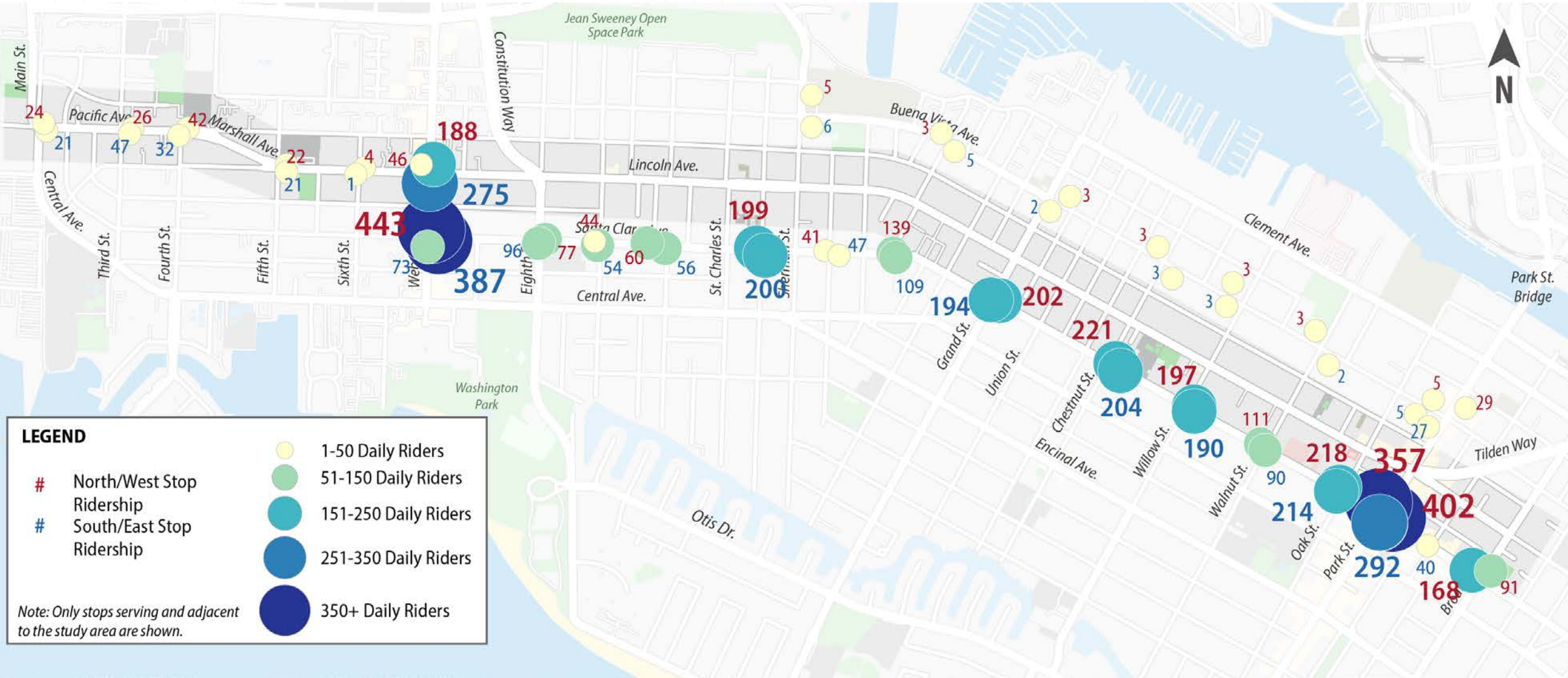

Background: 258 Reported Crashes in 5 Years

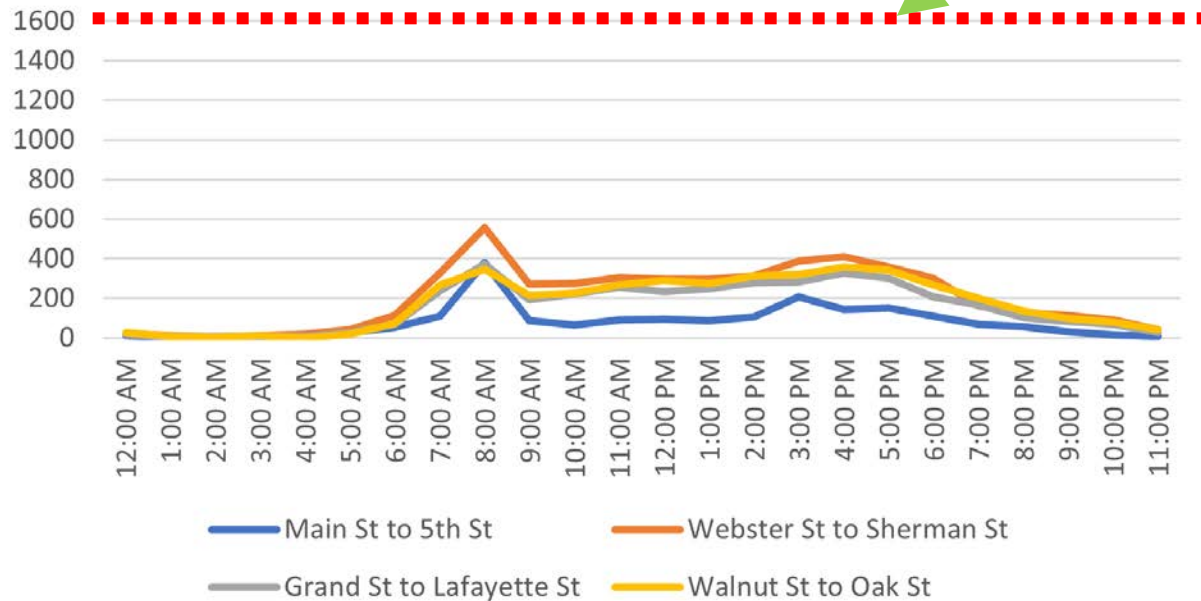
- 258 reported crashes from 2017-2021:

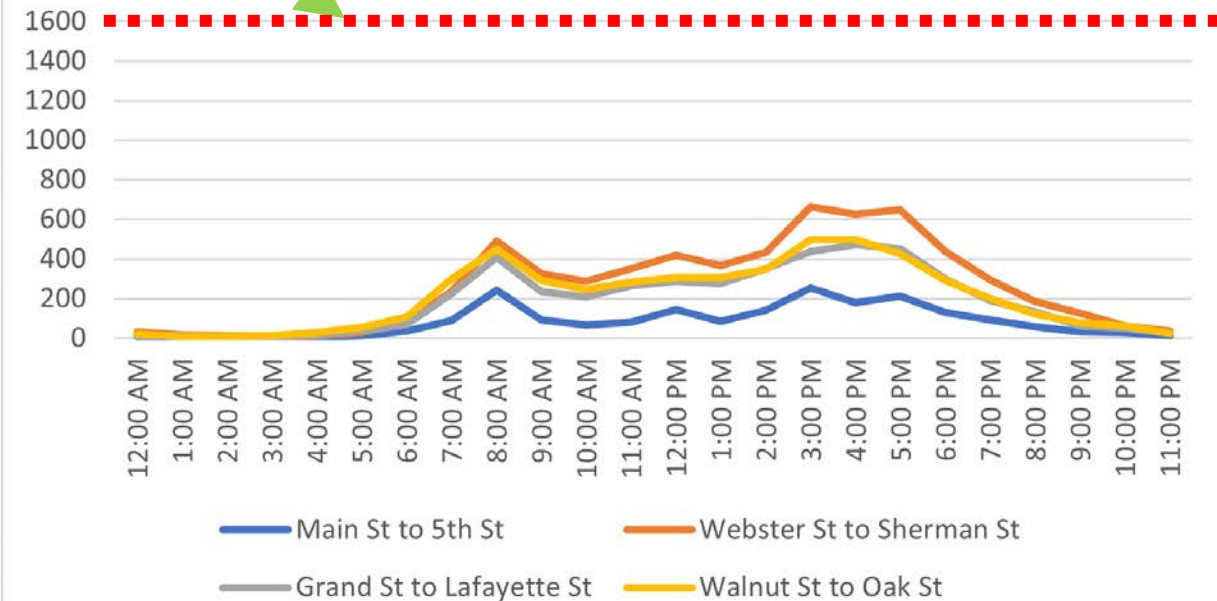
Background: Capacity > Demand

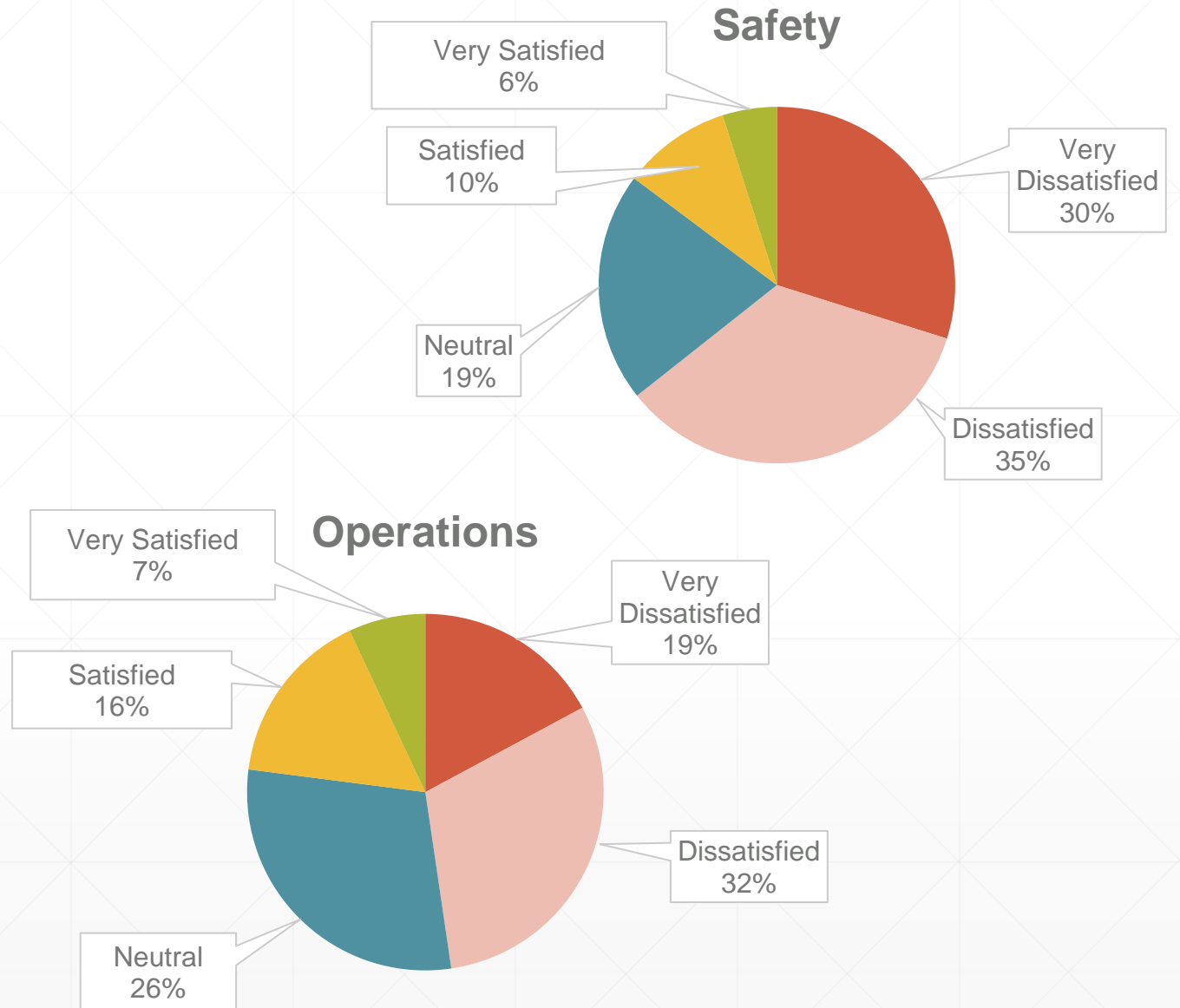

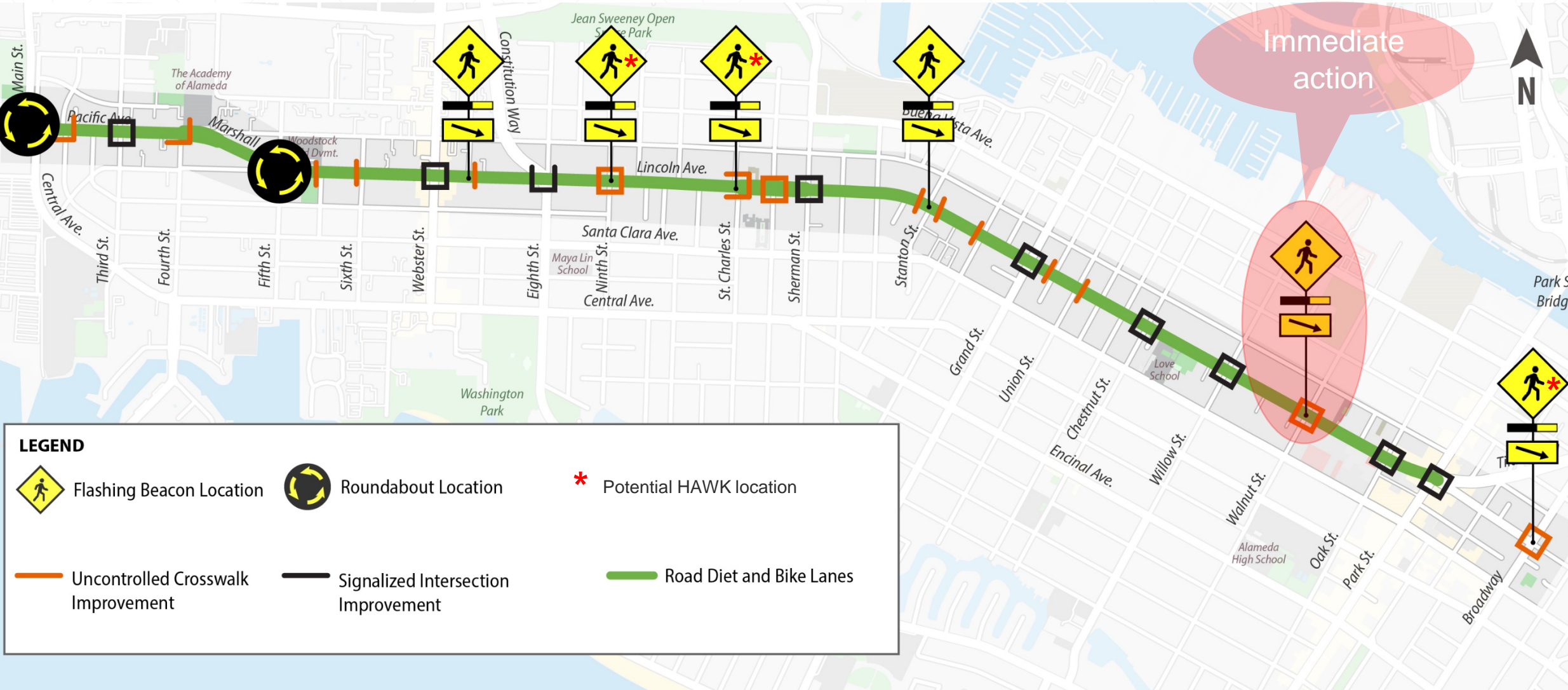

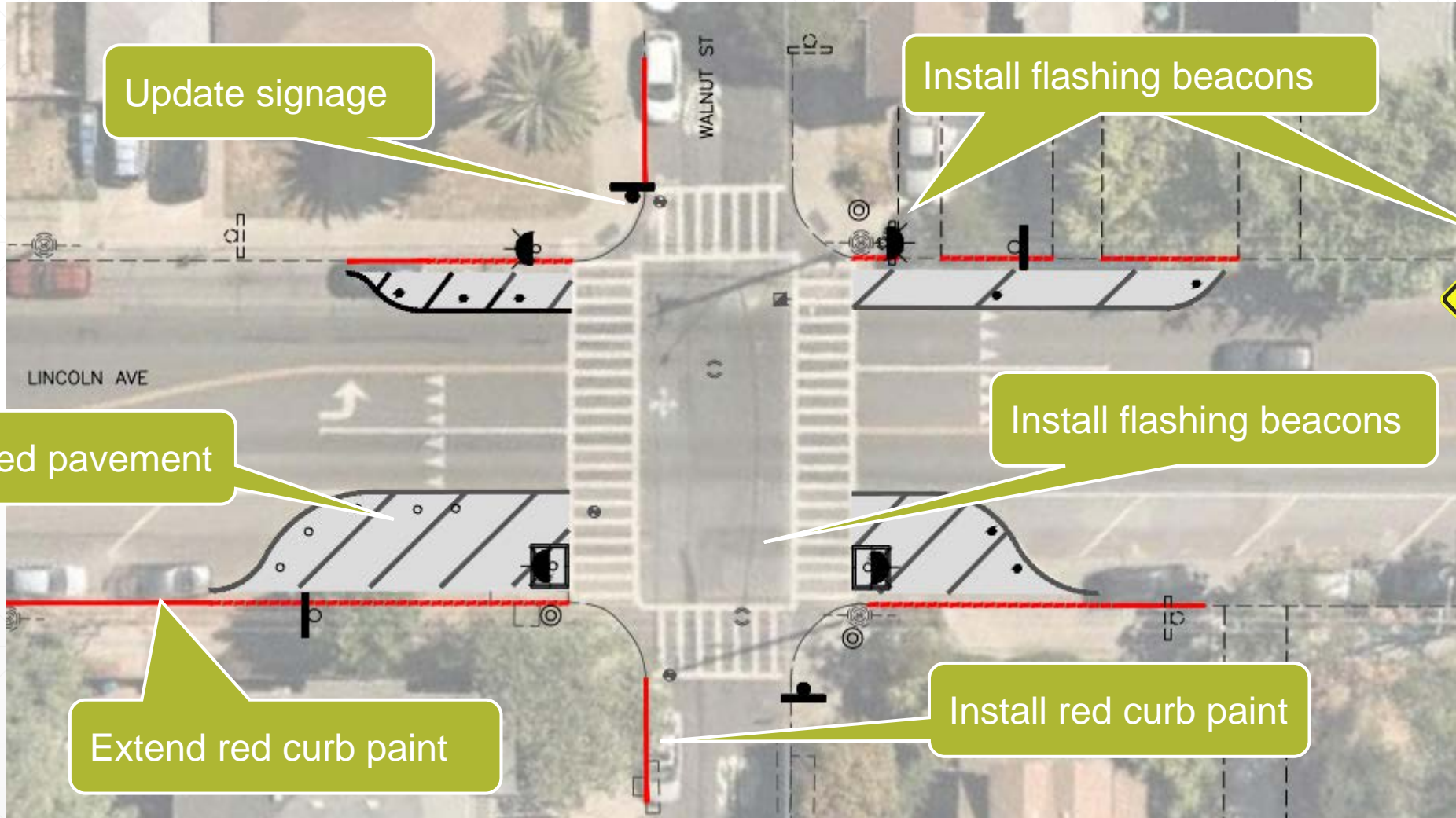

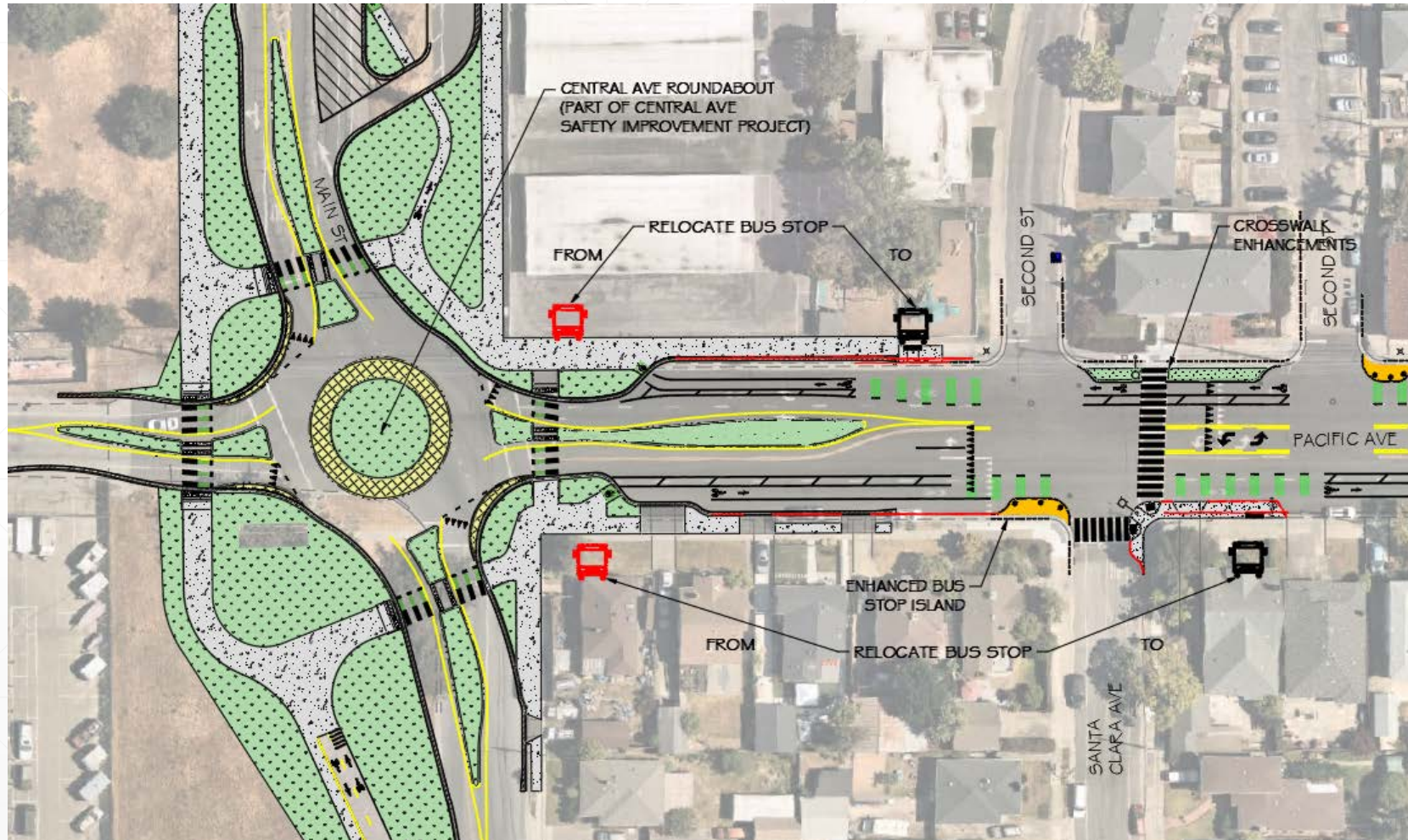

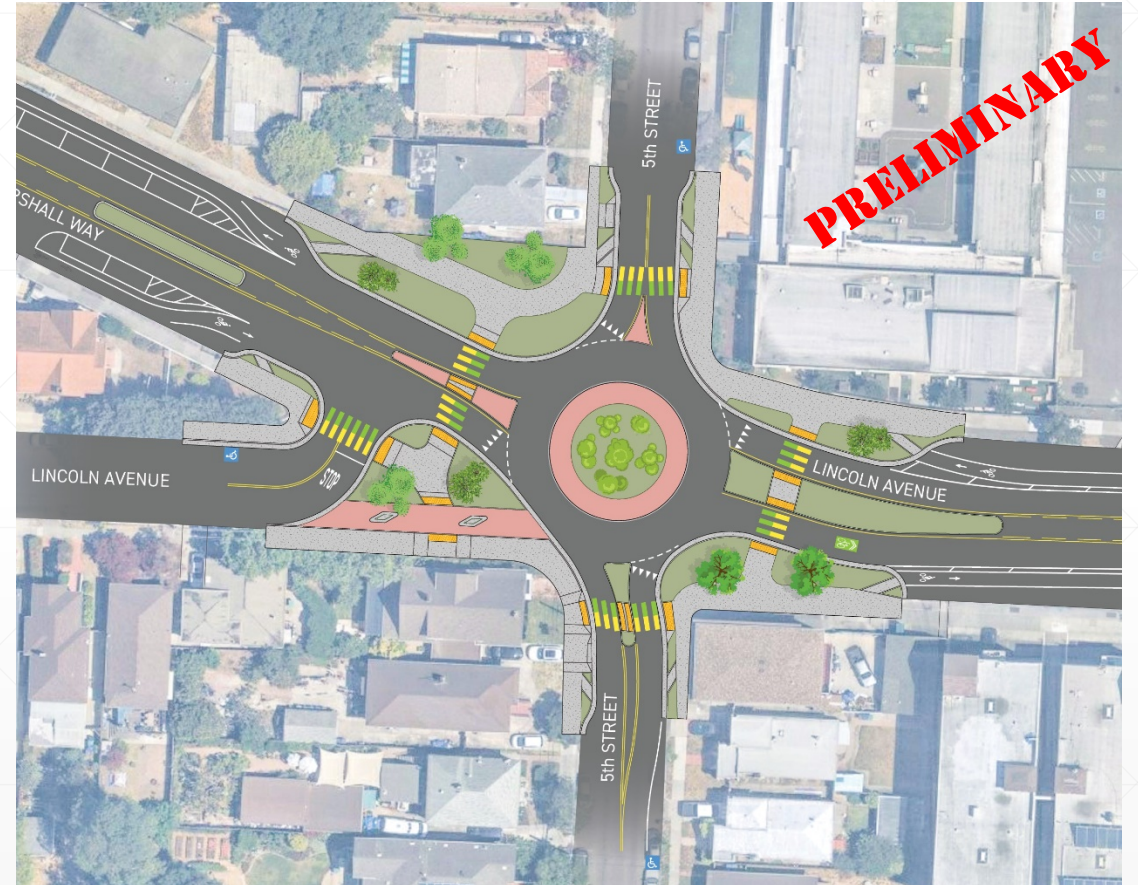

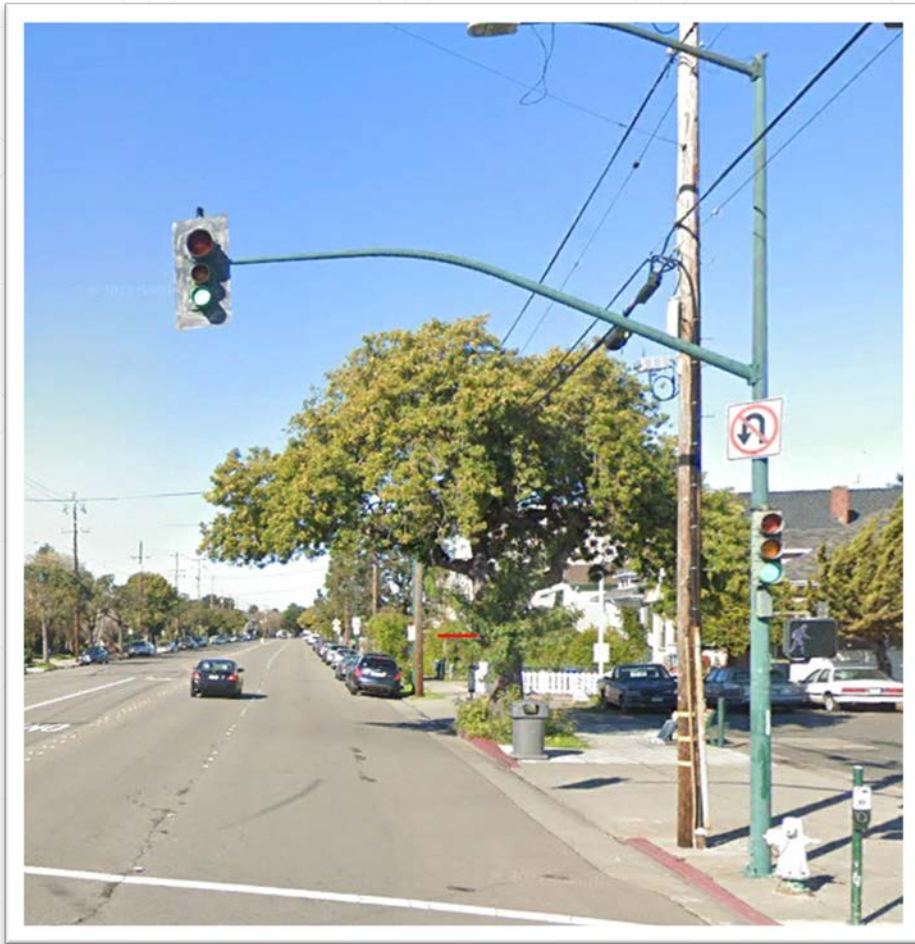

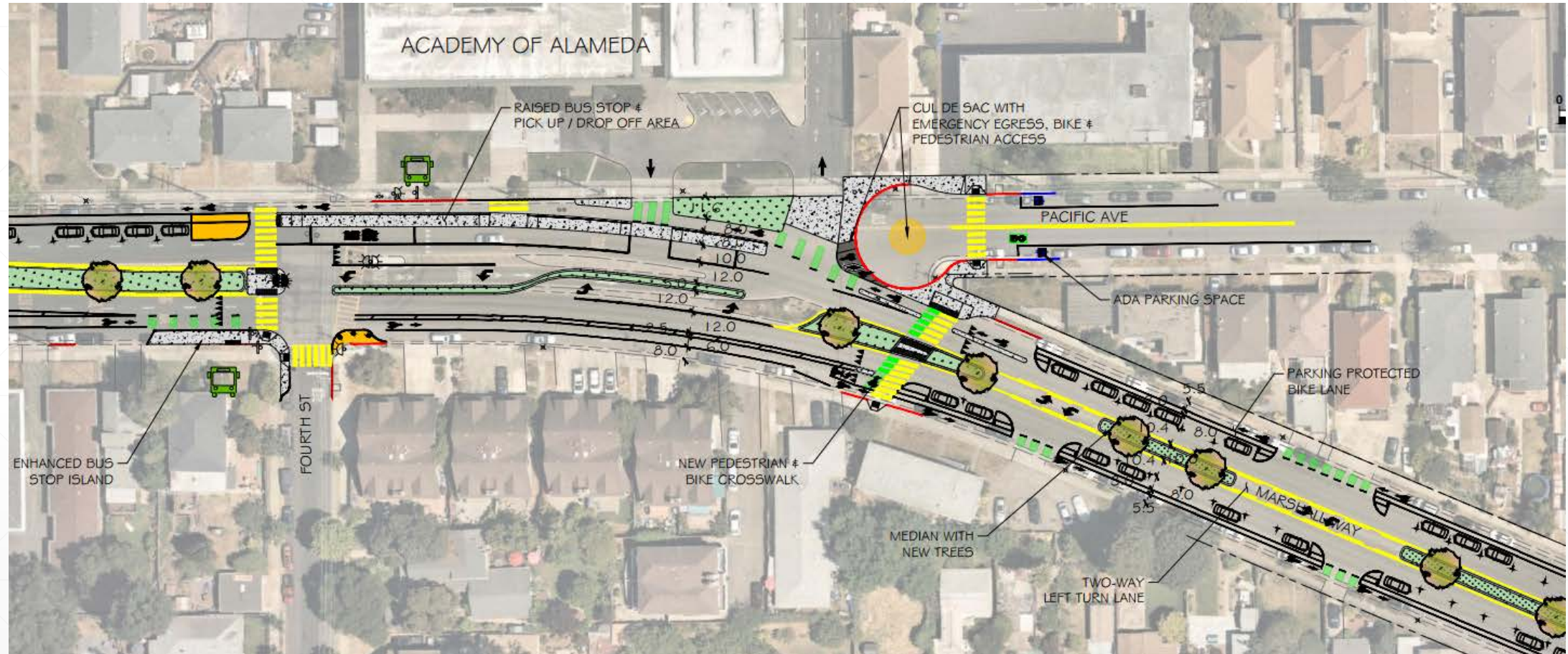
