
- Slow Streets are safer streets

Recommendation

Approve a one-year extension of the Slow Streets program through December 2022





2022: Slow Streets Enhancements

- Make lower-cost safety and usability enhancements
 - Daylighting
 - Turn restrictions at the larger intersections
 - Additional barricades
 - Flex posts in place of cones
 - With street repaving in 2022, install up to 2 simple traffic circles along Pacific Ave, and add striping and signage to Pacific and Santa Clara



2022: Finish ATP

 Complete Active Transportation Plan in 2022





Recommendation & Alternatives

- Recommendation: Maintain all 4.7 miles of Slow Streets for one more year
- Alternative 1: Terminate program and remove all Slow Streets
- Alternative 2: Modify program by removing select streets or street segments
