RE PUBLIC NOTICE: There has been inadequate public notice and participation for the substantial changes for Alameda Point Site A and West Midway since the General Plan Housing Amendment since at least December 2021. To further my point: the City does not have adequate information for ANY important development projects or meeting dates on their website or anywhere else. In this day and age, "printing them in the paper" is wholly inadequate and impedes public participation (contrary to the General Plan goals). They should have announcements on the website with links to issues of public interest, email notification by sign-up, Facebook posts etc. Neighborhood flyers should also have information/links to projects, and should be provided for all the surrounding neighborhoods, at least within 500 feet.
