The Problem

- Seniors face isolation and lack of support
 - Single mothers face housing instability and economic pressure
 - Children lack consistent community and mentorship

The Vision

A thoughtfully designed community that:

- Provides stable housing

 - Reduces loneliness and strengthens families
 - Creates a replicable model for other cities

Initial Scale (Exploratory)

- ~150 senior units
 - ~100 family units (single mothers + children)
