

- Concern about bunching and delays if 51A & 51B are combined





Support Increasing Service to Alameda's Trunk Line: 51A



- 51A Important to Alameda Seniors and People with Disabilities


City of Alameda Free AC Transit Pass Program

- **Line 96: Need 15 minute peak hour service to receive State Affordable Housing & Sustainable Communities funding for RESHAP**







Line F20 will serve Bay Farm, Otis, South Shore, Shoreline, Central, Main, Stargell.


Line F39 will run from South Shore to Fruitvale/Macarthur, with every other trip continuing along Lincoln and Skyline Blvd.
