help with library operations. The Behavior Policy will have to be revised before implementing the new incident tracking system and will go to the Library Board for review and approval at the January meeting.

There were no changes to the Draft Minutes of the September 11, 2024 Library Board Meeting. President Amarasiriwardena moved to accept the Consent Calendar. Board Member Battle seconded the motion, which passed with a 5-0 vote.
