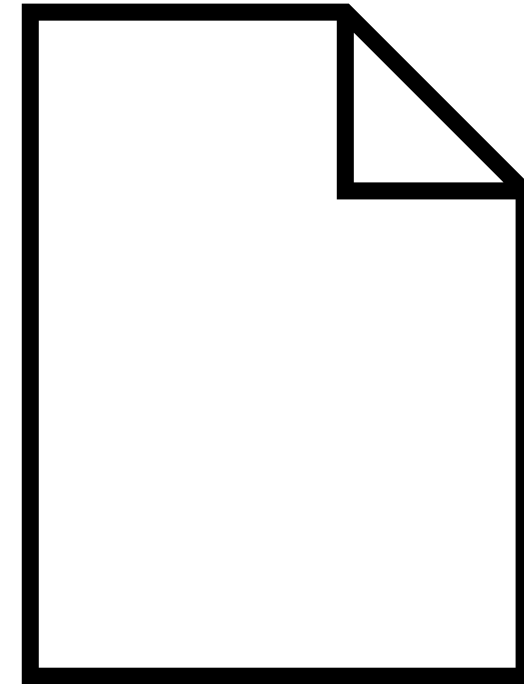

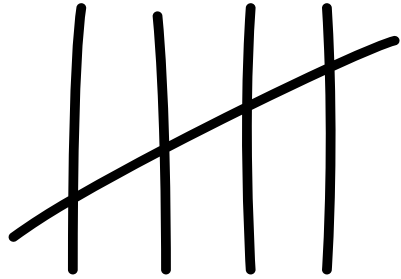


- Board Policy 501: Bus Stop Guidelines five-year update

- Goals: more customer-focused and guidance for decision-making

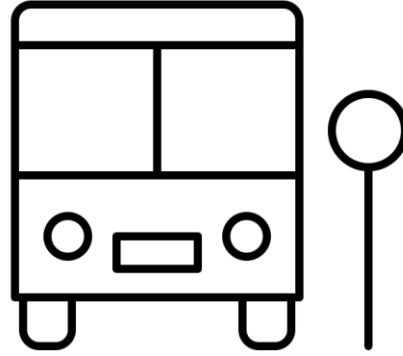

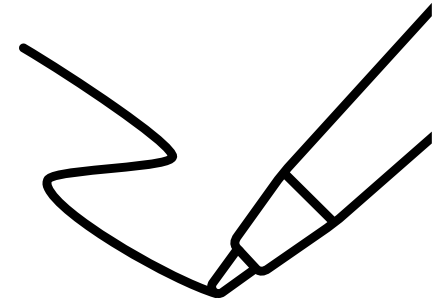

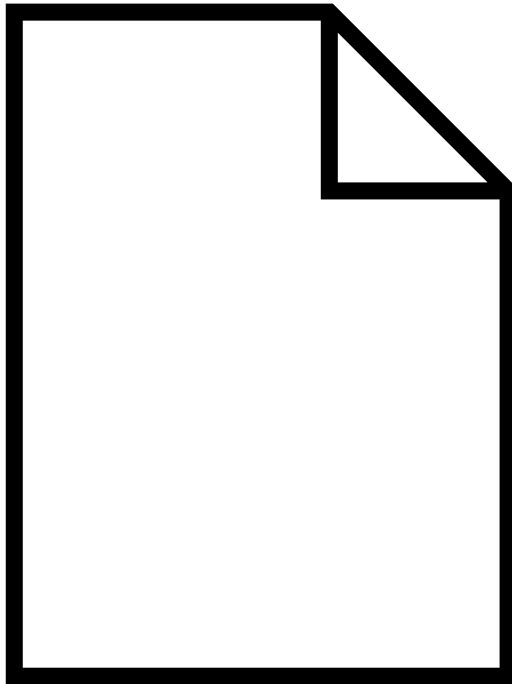
