


### Fire Tower Paint Beautification Concept:

The fire tower facade will be restored and painted to highlight the architectural details, fenestration, fire escape, etc. A mural will be added to the East Elevation which will wrap on other sides. See proposed Mural Exhibit under separate cover.









### Pollinator Garden Concept Narrative:

The site beautification is a pollinator garden that will provide habitat for pollinators and also consist of a drought tolerant plant palette to increase water conservation. The garden will use gravel and planting mulch to provide pathways for maintenance and access. The existing city street right of way is to be cleaned up and the existing concrete retaining wall between city right of way and fire tower site will be cleaned up and landscape debris removed. There will be a new gate added at the entrance point, with see-through fences on the perimeter of the golf course edges.









PRELIMINARY PLANT PALETTE INCLUDES: lavendars, salvias, penstemons, gaura, poppies, echinacea, rudebekkia, native grasses, butterfly bush, and ceanothus.





### **DESIGN INSPIRATIONS:**

Symbols of community environments represented through native plant and marine life

**Kelp:** Taking inspiration from the marine ecosystem along Alameda's shorelines, kelp symbolizes a place for community. Kelp forests are essential to the health of the ocean and our planet by providing habitat for abundant biodiversity.

**Black Sage**: Black Sage is one of the most widespread of the California Salvia species, ranging from the coastal ranges in the bay area to Baja California. It is a "keystone species" of coastal sage scrub and chaparral plant communities, meaning that it is a species which many other species within those ecosystems depend upon.
