


Background

- 2020/2021 COVID-19 Response: Park and Webster restriped from 4-lane cross section to:
  - One lane in each direction with left turn lanes at intersections
  - Parklets along curbline with floating parking
- Nov. 2021: Parklet program + restriping extended to Nov. 2023 by City Council
  - New agreements and updated parklet standards
  - Concrete barricades required around parklets
- 2022/2023: Current Parklets: Webster 3, Park 19



## **Existing Conditions: Challenges**





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## **Project Goals**

- Implement Council-directed concrete barricades around parklets
- Improve aesthetics of commercial corridors
- Clarify parking locations, increase parking compliance, limit double parking
- Begin implementing ATP near-term goals for bicycle facilities on the commercial corridors
- Prepare for parklet program to continue past November 2023

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#### **Staff Recommendations**

- 1. Maintain the parklet program with modifications
- 2. Maintain two travel lanes for automobiles and buses
- 3. Move the parking lane to the edge of the curb
- 4. Add striped bicycle lanes between the parking lane and the travel lane

# Parking Changes – Preliminary

- Webster Street
  - Central to Lincoln
  - Recover 13 parking spaces (tentative)
- Park Street
  - San Jose to Webb
  - Remove 18 parking spaces (tentative)
  - Includes parking reduction at existing parklets and at Central Ave.
     intersection where parking was recently restored at the curb



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#### **Next Steps**

- Summer 2023
  - Present recommendations to City Council
  - Continue community and business outreach
  - Identify areas for ADA & short term parking
  - Issue RFP for approved barricades
  - Develop final striping plans and bid for construction
- Fall 2023
  - Purchase concrete barricades
  - Execute new agreements for parklets with new guidelines
  - Implement striping & barricade placement
- Continue planning for ultimate configuration
