# Supplementary Service

- Supplementary Service lines (600-series) are scheduled to align with certain school(s) bell times.
- Supplementary Service trips are provided throughout AC Transit's service area to meet the demand for increased capacity at bell times.
- Resources limit how much supplementary service can be offered.
- Trips typically align with existing bus stops/route segments.
- Supplementary Service lines are open to all riders.
- **Bell schedule changes have an impact on students' ability to use transit if not coordinated with AC Transit.**

# ACTC Student Transit Pass Program (STPP)

- Funded by ACTC via Measure BB (2014)
- Implemented in 2017
- Presently serving 132 schools in Alameda County
- Qualified students in Alameda County can obtain a Clipper card with a pass, allowing them to ride local AC Transit lines for free.
- AC Transit works closely with ACTC to assist with the program's development and implementation.
- **For Alameda USD, only 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> graders whose families meet the free or reduced-priced meal income eligibility guidelines can apply for a free Student Transit Pass.**
  - Students who do not qualify can apply for a Youth Clipper Card (available to anyone under 19 and provides a 50% discount on transit)
