SSHRB Purpose & Work Plan Responsibilities

SSHRB Purpose:

Create an environment which will encourage and bring about mutual understanding, respect and good will among groups of people in the community and to improve social services in the community. (AMC 2-9.1)

SSHRB Duty:

Adopt a plan for the performance of its functions "with the advice and consent of the City Council" and to "meet at least once a year to review the plan." (AMC 2-9.4f)

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Last Year's Work Plan

- The Road Home Work Group
 - Continue to address The Road Home Strategy 3.1 and develop a plan to engage the community on the regional crisis of homelessness.
 - Produce an annual report on The Road Home
- Human Relations/Alamedans Together Against Hate Work Group (now Alamedans United Against Hate)
 - Continue to coordinate with other human relations initiatives and collaborate with partners by participating in community meetings, events, focus groups, and/or stakeholder meetings to improve and support human relations in Alameda.
 - Bring revised ATAH resolution to City Council for consideration of approval.
- Domestic Violence Work Group
 - Collaborate with local agencies and organizations to build on current structures/systems for the
 expressed purpose of supporting victims, perpetrators, and youth to encourage access to
 services and resources.
