The same standard applies to <u>all projects at the Point</u>:--reports should come from properly qualified, independent consultants---I previously provided a report by VerPlanck Historical Consultants as a model.

Also remember: All boards have the right to set their own agenda and establish their own bylaws-. Allen Tai, as a City employee, should not control your information or agenda—this is a citizen oversight board, and such involvement is a clear conflict of interest. The City has been undermining your authority for years; it's time to reclaim it.
