- 332 affordable housing units, including 201 replacement units
- Project includes workforce development center – Barn

RESHAP Timeline

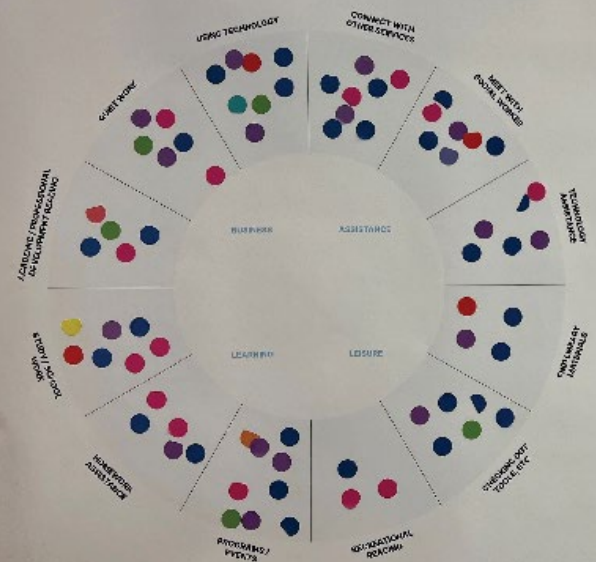
- September 2023 – discussions began
- June 2024 – demolition and site preparation begins
- March 2026 – housing construction begins
- March 2028 – construction of first phase complete

Preliminary Planning for Alameda Point Library

- April 16 Outreach to Alameda Point Collaborative residents
- Placement of branch library within the site
- Space allocation within proposed 4800 ft² building
