Emergency Supportive Housing

- ▶ New Proposal
 - Three homes
 - One home is for up to six individuals
 - Two homes are for families
- ▶ Program Participants Reduced
 - prior program 30 - 32 beds
 - revised program 14 - 19 beds

Repair, Remodeling, Painting and Furnishing

- ▶ The homes will be refurbished
 - Painting inside on the ranch and or townhouse(s)
 - Painting on the interior and exterior of the Big White
 - Rekeying
 - New flooring
 - Setting up the home for occupancy

Housing First

- ▶ Housing First principles will be used to support the residents
 - Low barrier
 - Quickly and successfully connect households experiencing homelessness to permanent housing
 - Supportive services on a voluntary basis to maximize housing stability and prevent returns to homelessness

Service provider



- ▶ Staff is recommending the Village of Love as the service provider
 - Village of Love is currently the City's partner at the Day Center, Day Center Overnight, and Safe Parking

Recommendation

- ▶ Provide direction on the type of Emergency Supportive Housing program to be offered by the City, including the population to be served
- ▶ Provide direction on whether staff should pursue a service provider agreement with the Village of Love
