What is CDBG?

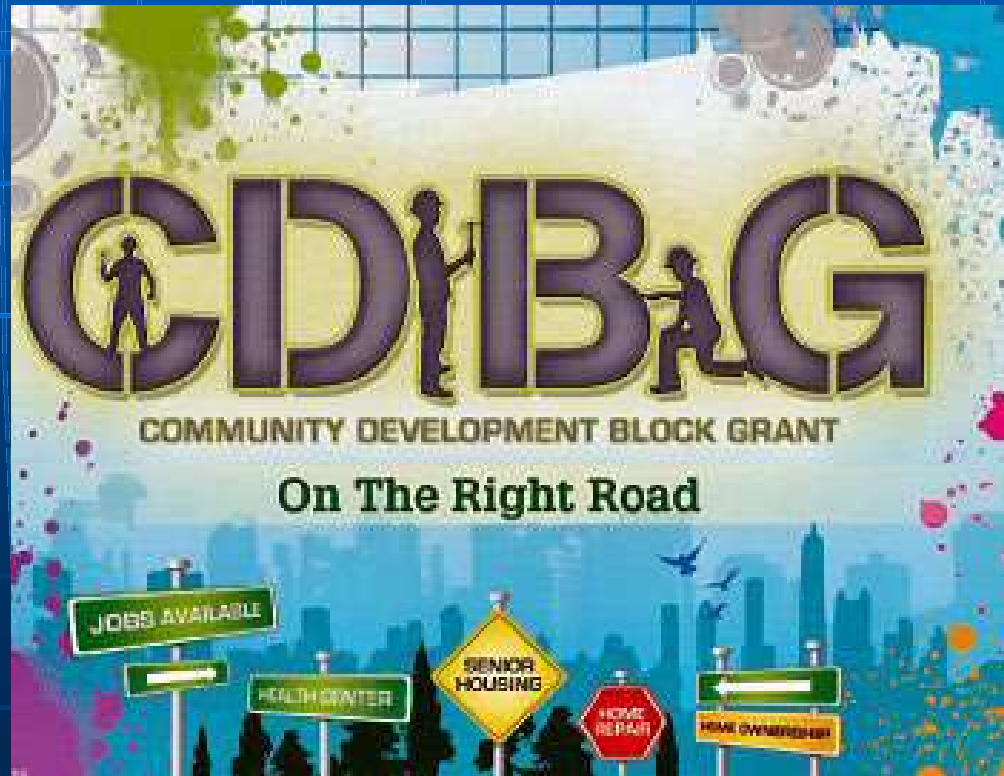
Federal funds to assist low- and moderate-income persons by providing:

- Decent Housing
- Suitable Living Environment
- Expanded Economic Opportunities

Non-Housing Public Service Priorities

Five Year Strategic Plan 2020-2025

Preserve Alameda's "Safety Net" services by prioritizing funding for programs that address:

- Affordable housing, fair housing and housing support for Tenant/landlord mediation, counseling and tenant's rights
- Food security and food services
- Homeless services
- Mental health services
- Safety and crime prevention
- Transportation and pedestrian safety

Outreach to Stakeholders

Staff contacted 23 local service providers and asked three questions:

1. What services does your organization provide?
2. What do you see as the biggest need for the communities you serve?
3. What do you feel is often unknown or unseen about the communities you serve, which would be helpful for the public to understand?

FY2023-24 Needs Process

- **Step 1:** Social Service Human Relations Board hears this presentation, receives public comments, and directs the preparation of a Needs Statement to confirm the ongoing needs for FY 2023-24.
- **Step 2:** SSHRB President prepares the community needs statement.
- **Step 3:** City Council hears public comment and adopts the Needs Statement for the FY 2023-24 Action Plan. **(January 3, 2023)**
