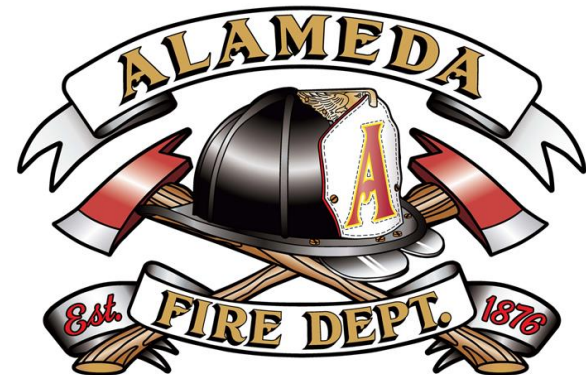


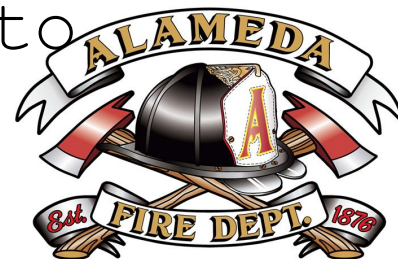

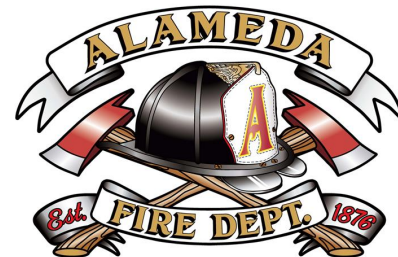
What is the Emergency Operations Plan?

- A document that outlines an organization's response to an emergency or disaster
- Two main parts:
 - Basic Plan: The portion of the document that is not incident specific and outlines organizational structure to emergency operations
 - Annexes/Appendices: Outlines incident specific responses in concert with the basic plan
- Serves as a guiding document to the organizations response and empowers staff to make decisions based on their professional experience and judgement.



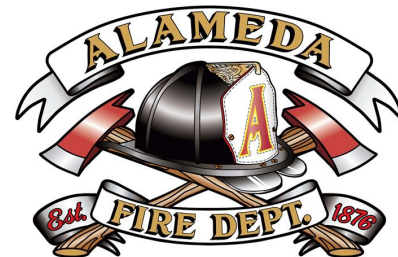
2025 Revision

- 2025 Revision being completed by Atlas Planning based out of Southern California



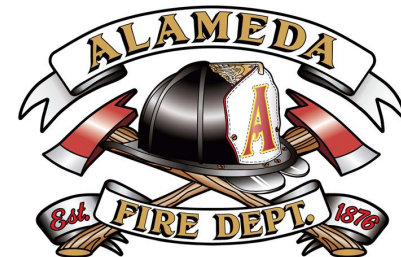
Key Areas of Focus for Revision
