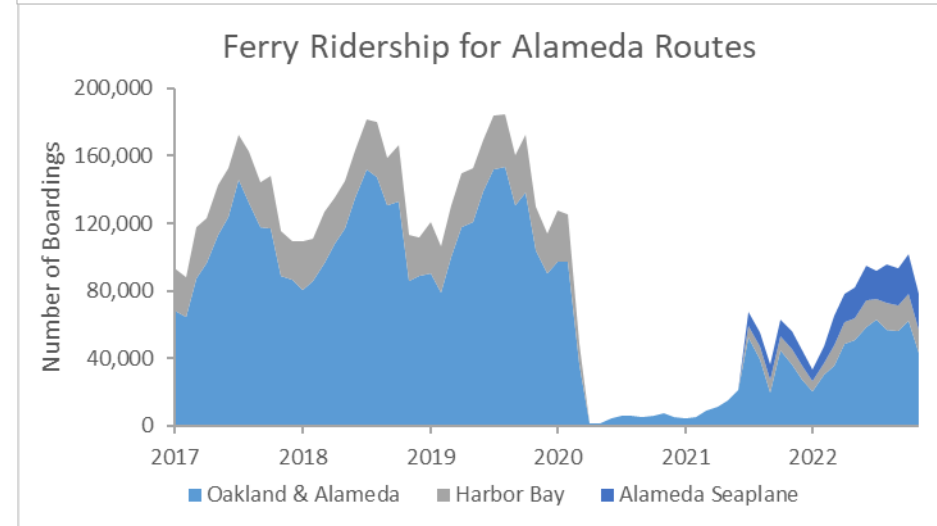
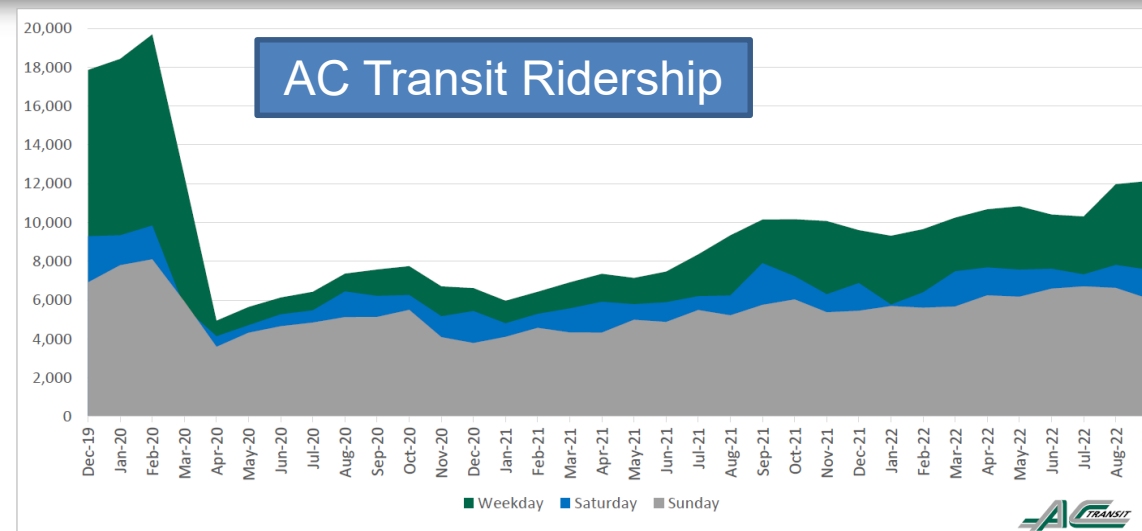

2022 Public Transit Trends

- **AC Transit Alameda routes**
 - Ridership up 60%
 - Still 55% of pre-pandemic
- **Alameda Free AC Transit Bus Pass Pilot**
 - For seniors and people with disabilities
 - 5,900 trips per month as of Dec 2022
- **Ferry/WETA:**
 - Alameda ridership up 103%
 - 3,250 Alameda boardings in 12/2022
 - System wide, 65% weekday pre-pandemic and 100% weekend

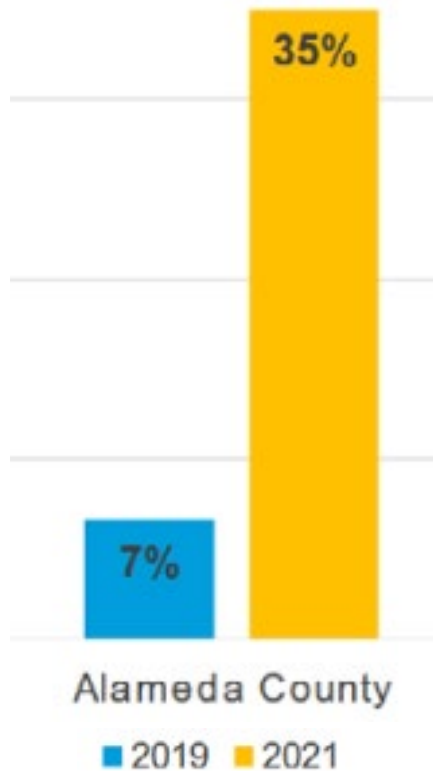

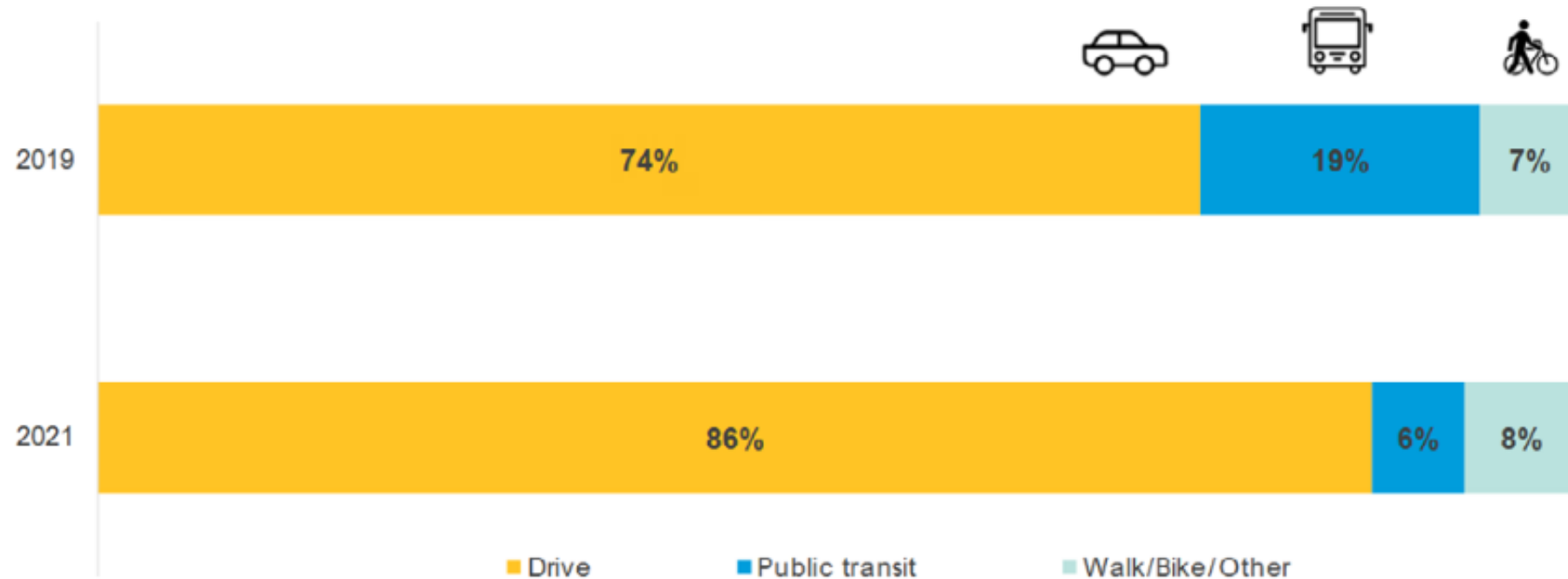


Alameda County Commute Trends 2021 vs 2019
