

REGISTRAR OF VOTERS CERTIFICATE TO PETITION

I, **Tim Dupuis**, Registrar of Voters for the County of Alameda, State of California, hereby certify that: An Initiative Petition titled: A Proposed City of Alameda Charter Amendment to Establish Rent Control. A Rent Control Board and Regulate Termination of Tenancies, was filed with the Alameda City Clerk within the statutory time limit and forwarded to this office for verification on May 24, 2016 and;

The petition contained 7,871 unverified signatures; and

Pursuant to California Elections Code section 9215, in order to be sufficient, the petition must have been signed by 6,461 qualified registered voters in the City of Alameda, that number being equal to 15 percent of 43,073 total registered voters of the City at the time of filing the Notice of Intent, and;

I have examined, or caused to be examined, signatures on the petition pursuant to California Elections Code sections 9211 and 9115; and

Have determined that the petition contained 463 valid signatures of qualified registered voters in the City of Alameda based on the random sample examination set forth in section 9115 and the formula prescribed by the California Secretary of State; and

That this number represents 113% of the total number of signatures needed to qualify the initiative; therefore

The petition is found to be sufficient to require the City Council of the City of Alameda to take the appropriate action specified in the California Elections Code.
