

Capital Budget Overview


- Proposed **\$31.8 million in FY 2021-22** and **\$35.2 million for FY 2022-23**, including \$18.1 million in grant funding over two-year period.
- Only \$800,000/year of General Fund contribution (2% of two year budget)
- Executing on City Council priorities:
 - Vision Zero and Traffic Safety 
 - Climate Action and Resiliency 
 - Recreation and Parks Facility Improvements 
 - Renewal of Alameda Point Infrastructure



Ongoing Projects – No Additional Capital Funding Request

- Alameda Point Adaptive Reuse Backbone Infrastructure: project funded in previous budgets. Construction expected to begin in the winter of 2021.



- Clement Avenue and Tilden Way Complete Street: planning, design and property acquisition funded in previous budgets. Construction funding to be requested in future budgets.



- Appezzato Parkway Bus Lanes: planning and design funded in previous budgets. Construction funding to be requested in future budgets.
