- State what you will do when the safety of any of our residents, businesses, community members or visitors, regardless of ethnic or national origin, gender, gender identity and expression, race, religious affiliation, sexual orientation or immigration status, is endangered.
- Specifically, affirm that you will:
 - Prohibit federal immigration enforcement from being able to access city facilities or to use city resources in the pursuit of immigration enforcement.
 - Refuse sharing data between immigration authorities and city officials and agencies.
 - Prohibit city employees from working with federal law enforcement on immigration matters.
 - Prohibit local police from making arrests for federal immigration violations, or to detain individuals on civil immigration warrants.
 - Forbid any city entity to enter into a contract with the federal government to detain immigrants.
 - Forbid police or other city workers to ask about immigration status.
 - Refuse to allow ICE into local jails without a judicial warrant.
