While I suppose the Central Ave plans as explained in the Alameda Sun are cast in concrete, I'd still like to express my objections. As to safety issues, I doubt that accidents on Central Ave, based on accidents per vehicle traffic count, are higher than several other streets in Alameda. Do we have any data to support accidents per traffic density on Central or any other streets in Alameda? Are we going to do this Encinal or other streets?

While I agree bicycling is good exercise and environmentally friendly, travel by automobiles, trucks and buses is, and always will be, the predominate mode of transportation in this country. Therefore, it should be the major consideration in traffic planning. In addition, I have never seen a significant use of these bicycle lane in Alameda. I recently traveled the length of Shoreline Drive and didn't see one bicycle in the lanes. Although, I did see one mother pushing a baby stroller!

My understanding is the Shoreline Drive project cost hundreds of thousands of dollars and I don't really see what it accomplished. Now we want to spend an equal amount of taxpayers dollars on a similar project. I don't understand the need to constantly change things that will produce little benefit, there are better places to spend our money.

Dear Mayor and Council Members,

What are you thinking? The bike lanes at South Shore have destroyed what was one of the nicest streets in Alameda. I used to love walking and driving on it but now it looks like a parking lot. The buses need to straddle the yellow line as the lanes are not wide enough and when one stops traffic backs up until the bus moves on. And you want to do the same thing to Central? I walk the trail at South Shore often and on the weekdays I rarely see more than one bicycle. On weekends there are more but it's hard to believe that all that money was spent for weekend outings. Central Ave has businesses that need to unload their merchandise. With 2 lanes in each direction it is no problem when a truck blocks one lane even if they are across the street from one another. There are driveways that residents back out of. You are going to make them back over the side walk, pass a cycle track, pass parked cars and then out into the traffic? That's crazy!

With all the development that is currently taking place the car traffic will increase. We need the thoroughfares that we have. Santa Clara already has a bike lane and the traffic lanes are wide enough that the cars and bikes aren't competing for the roadway.

For some reason the "Bike People" were able to ram through South Shore perhaps with support from the residents who live there who no longer have to move their cars. They are a very vocal group but not all people can or want to ride bikes. In regards to the safety issue for the school children, lighted sidewalks like the ones by Lum School and Otis School and on Park St stop the traffic and allow for a safe crossing.

I urge you NOT to approve taking away a major transportation route for the sake of a few cyclists.
