



City of Alameda Transportation Commission Resolution Recognizing the Service of Rebecca Kohlstrand

WHEREAS, the City of Alameda is an island community with a unique combination of transportation options and challenges; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Commission was established to advise the City Council on transportation policies and to monitor the implementation of transportation plans; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, Rebecca Kohlstrand was appointed by the Mayor and the City Council to serve as a member of the Transportation Commission, and has served four years; and

WHEREAS, Rebecca Kohlstrand previously served on the City of Alameda Planning Board from 2004-2012, including one year as Vice President and one year as President; and
