The Performing Arts Center is a hub for live performances—a place to celebrate our collective experiences.

The center will be a vibrant hub that celebrates and elevates our community's diverse creativity, offering an accessible, professional space for local performers of all ages and skill levels to showcase their talents. At its core, is a state-of-the-art, 600-seat theater comparable in size to the Freight & Salvage or the Berkeley Repertory Theater. Equipped with cutting-edge technology, the theater will be designed to accommodate a wide range of performances, including music, dance, and theater, ranging from local East Bay artists to touring and international acts, amateur to professional.
