Clarify that the Previously Approved Animal Shelter Operator Agreement with Friends of the Alameda Animal Shelter Includes an Annual Increase Based on the Percentage Change in the Consumer Price Index for a Total 10-Year Compensation Estimate of \$11,574,639





Background

- In 2017, City Council approved a renegotiated contract for animal shelter services with the Friends of the Alameda Animal Shelter (FAAS)
- In 2021, City Council approved a new 2-year contract with up to four 2-year extensions with FAAS
- In May 2023, the City Council's approved 2023-2025 budget included funding for FAAS
- In June 2023, the City Manager approved a 2-year extension of the FAAS contract for 2023-2025



Background

- The 2017 and 2021 agreements included the **contract amount and an** annual upwards adjustment based on the CPI, which has varied from 3.5% - 5.2%.
- The 2021 staff report and agreement did not include an estimated amount for the entire 10-year period, should all four 2-year extensions be authorized.
- For purposes of clarification, the table in the staff report establishes an estimated 10-year amount **based on a 5% estimate** of the percentage change in the CPI. Future increases will be based on the actual CPI.
- Any future annual compensation is subject to City Council approval. If the City Council does not appropriate sufficient funds during future budget processes, staff will either bring a new contract to Council with at least 90 days' notice or recommend terminating the agreement.
