Residents would like the library to be a place for kids and adults.

It should be open all year around to allow residents who have visiting families such as grandchildren to be able to take advantage.

Desired services at the library:

- Education component -
 - Computer classes, election/ballot measure education, study groups (study rooms), lifesaving classes such as CPR, Heimlich maneuver, certification programs, STEM class, Resume Ready, Craft room, bike maintenance classes, classes to learn about working with children with developmental disabilities such as autism.
- Community component -
 - interactive teen services (no screens), childrens' storytime, motivational speakers, movie nights and movie lending, women support groups (Shiela Smith, a resident, would like to run it), meditation space, bike parking

Other feedback:

- People speaking different languages should work at the library to reflect the world we live in.
- A resident (Pamela), who is also on the board of APC, prefers not to have the library on RESHAP land.
 - The resident does not go to the library as everything is available on laptop and phones; other services are already available via APC.
 - Land should be used for more comfortable housing such as private open space, in-unit laundry (community laundry is terrible – dirty diapers in washers/dryers), provide storage units.
 - The City should build the library on their own land.
