My name is Tom Krysiak and I'm a long time resident of Harbor Bay Alameda as well as an avid supporter of the Parcel 4 project to complete and maintain the Bay Trail. Our family and friends frequently use this walking trail especially during these restrictive pandemic times. This unfinished section of the shoreline path affords beautiful bay vistas that must be enhanced and protected. After twenty five years, the City of Alameda finally took title to this parcel in 2019 and President Biden's ARP program just granted the City of Alameda \$28 Million.
