Audit Recap

- Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR) audit performed in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards
- Maze & Associates, the City's external auditor, obtained reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement
- Audit fieldwork and testing took place between October 2023 and March 2024

Audit Results

- The City received a "clean" ACFR audit opinion
 - Unmodified opinion financial statements are prepared using U.S. (GAAP)
 - Financial statements are fairly presented and do not contain material misstatements
- The City's seven other financial and compliance reports all received "clean" reviews with no findings

What's New in Finance?

- First ACFR created "In-House"
 - More time for Finance Dept. to gather data and produce financial statements and compliance reports
 - Increases transparency Finance Dept. can spend more time analyzing financial results and variances
 - Public confidence Creating financial statements saves time for external auditors who may focus more on performing audit procedures and performing risk analyses
- Received GFOA's Certificate for Excellence in Financial Reporting for 3rd year in a row


