

Our History

- ★ Alameda Family Services has provided health and wellness services in the City of Alameda for over 50 years
- ★ Formalized relationship with AUSD dates back to 1993 when AFS opened the first School Based Health Center (SBHC) at Alameda High School
- ★ Followed by Encinal High in 1999 and Island High in 2007
- ★ The SBHCs provided the foundation for the work we now deliver as part of a larger mental health support system across the district
- ★ Summer of 2021, AFS was awarded AUSD's School Based Counseling Program contract and now provides mental health in all 15 schools.




24 -25 and 25 -26 Data All Schools



Alameda Family Services School Health Centers (3 SHCs) Preliminary School Health Center Client and Visit Summary: July 2025-December 2025


The data in this report describe school health center (SHC) medical/health education services provided by Native American Health Center (NAHC) and behavioral health services by Alameda Family Services (AFS).

- Data only reflects SBHC services and does not reflect total number of services provided by AFS across AUSD



Alameda High School-Based Health Center Preliminary School Health Center Client and Visit Summary: July 2025-December 2025



Our AHS Health Center is at Risk

- ★ Long-time partner Native American Health Center has given notice at AHS
 - Their last day will be 4.10.2026
- ★ Negotiating with two new potential medical partners
 - Roots Community Clinic
 - La Familia
- ★ Both are requesting start-up funds to help bridge them in the first year of service



What We Risk Losing

- ★ Without a new medical partner, the AHS SchoolBased Health Center funding is at risk
- ★ If the AHS Health Center closes 1900 students will lose access to critical physical health services
 - 91% of medical visits have been for sexual and reproductive health



What We Risk Losing

- ★ AHS SBHC also supports the broader AHS community through outreach
 - Classroom presentations (on Mental Health, Sexual Health, Healthy Relationships, Alcohol and Other Drugs, and Nutrition and Body Image)
 - 1:1 Sexual Health Education.
 - Campus-wide campaigns: “You are Loved”- Suicide Prevention and Awareness Fair, Healthy Relationships, Mental Health Awareness, and more.
 - Youth Advisory Board
