NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at its meeting on Tuesday, June 4, 2024, the Alameda City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider:

Method of collecting the annual Water Quality and Flood Protection Fee for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 through the property tax bill system.

The Public Works Director has filed with the City Clerk a written report containing a description of each and every parcel of real property receiving the benefit of the storm drainage system for which the Fee is to be collected on the tax roll. This report contains the amount of the Water Quality and Flood Protection fees for each parcel for the forthcoming fiscal year, computed in conformity with the fees as prescribed by the municipal code.

Any owner of a parcel of real property subject to the Water Quality and Flood Protection Fee may object to having this fee collected through the property tax bill system by filing with the City Clerk a written protest containing a legible signature of the property owner and identifying the parcel by address or assessor's parcel number. Written protests can be mailed in advance of the public hearing to the City Clerks' office: 2263 Santa Clara, Alameda CA 94501. Please contact the City Clerk's office for information regarding written protests delivered in person prior to the June 4 Public Hearing. If the City Clerk does not receive written protests from the owners of a majority of properties regarding the collection method of this fee before the close of the public hearing, the City Council may authorize the collection of the Water Quality and Flood Protection Fee through the property tax bill system.
