CURFEW REGULATIONS

(Pursuant to Declaration of Local Emergency of March 17, 2020 and the authority of the Director of Emergency Services under Section 2-24.6 of the Alameda Municipal Code)

It shall be unlawful for any person to travel or be upon a public street, sidewalk, or public place within the City of Alameda during the dates and hours designated below, unless exempt for the reasons set forth below. For purposes of this Curfew, "travel" includes, without limitation, travel on foot, bicycle, skateboard, scooter, motorcycle, automobile, or public transit.

June 1, 2020, 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. on June 2, 2020 and

June 2, 2020, 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. on June 3, 2020

Exemptions: All law enforcement, fire, medical personnel, any essential governmental employees (including the City Manager, City Attorney and City Clerk and their designees), other government employees engaged in authorized emergency operations, members of the National Guard or any other responding military personnel deployed to the City, and authorized representatives of the news media, such as a news service, newspaper, radio or television station or network or other news media organization, are exempt from this Curfew. Individuals traveling directly to and from work, seeking emergency care, fleeing dangerous circumstances, or experiencing homelessness are also exempt.
