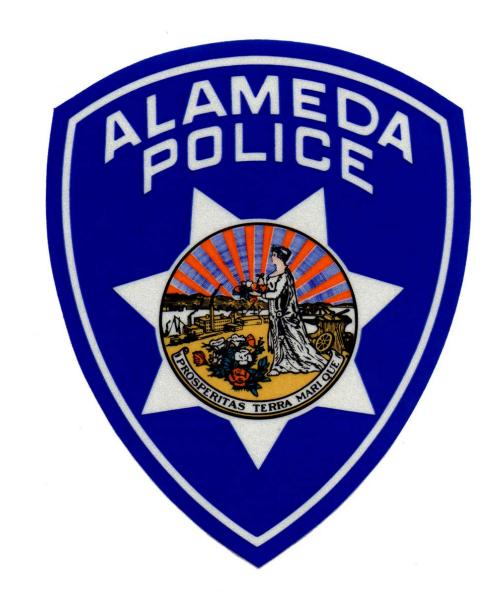
Alameda Police Fixed ALPR September 6, 2022



Timeline

February 2022 City Council approved fixed license plate readers

April 2022 City Council revised and approved APD's fixed license plate reader policy

May 2022 APD announced RFP

July 2022 APD received six proposals

A cross-section of members of the PD reviewed all packets and unanimously selected Flock as their preferred vendor

Why Flock Safety?

Footage owned by the City and will never by sold or shared by Flock

Customizable data retention features, which is then deleted and unrecoverable

Search reason required for audit trail (comports with adopted policy)

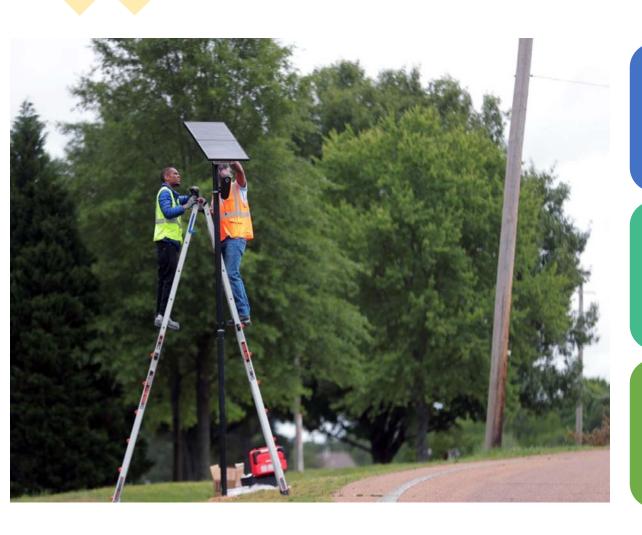
Does NOT use facial recognition software

NOT predictive policing

No personal identifying information contained in data

Not connected to registration data

Available transparency portal for improved community engagement



Minimal infrastructure required for the 35-camera system to monitor 14 locations throughout Alameda

Easy setup and/or removal powered by solar

Direct uploads into APD's digital evidence storage provider and is CJIS compliant
