PLN22-0316 - Administrative Use Permit - 200 Wind River Way - Applicant: Sean Howard. Public hearing to consider an administrative use permit to allow an approximately 9,600-square-foot outdoor miniature golf course at 200 Wind River Way. The golf course will be set up within the parking lot using portable objects and golf holes. The site will be surrounded by an 8-foot tall fence that maintains visibility into the golf course and retains golf balls within the course.
