A public hearing to consider an Administrative Use Permit to allow temporary construction material storage and staging for a current Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) retrofit project. The proposed staging facility encompasses an existing 44,000-square-foot warehouse and adjacent 80,000-square-foot yard areas. The proposed duration of the temporary storage facility is up to 48 months. Per AMC 30-4.24(g)10, use permits may be issued for interim uses such as construction staging activities, provided that the interim use does not exceed a five (5) year time period.
