## CITY OF ALAMEDA RESOLUTION NO.\_\_\_\_ ADOPTING THE VISION ZERO ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS, in November 2019, City Council adopted its Vision Zero policy declaring Vision Zero to be the guiding principle in all transportation efforts and requiring the development of a Vision Zero Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, Vision Zero is an international movement that provides a framework for reducing traffic deaths and life-changing injuries to zero, while increasing safe, healthy, equitable mobility for all; and

WHEREAS, from 2009-2018, an average of two people died, ten suffered severe injuries, and a total of 221 were injured per year on Alameda streets; and

WHEREAS, in 2019 one person died; in 2020 four people died; and in 2021 an additional four people died as a result of crashes in Alameda; and

WHEREAS, these terrible deaths affect families, loved ones, and broader communities, and not one of these deaths is acceptable; and

WHEREAS, the Alameda Vision Zero Action Plan includes over 50 actions aimed at achieving its vision of a city where "people of all ages can travel safely using any mode, and traffic deaths and serious injuries are eliminated by 2035."

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council adopts the five-year Alameda Vision Zero Action Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council supports the ambitious goal to eliminate traffic deaths and severe injuries by 2035.
