ARPD Mission and Goals

OUR GOAL...

To make public athletic facilities available to as many youth as possible for a variety of recreational opportunities.

Every kid deserves a chance to try and play as many sports as they choose.



Fair Play in Community Sports Act

- Girls must be provided participation opportunities at public athletic facilities that are equal in quality and scope to those provided to boys.
- ARPD's responsibility to allocate equally to girls or to the extent that our community's needs have been met.
- Overlaid first on all scheduling requests.
 - New forms: Girls teams, Boys teams, Co-Ed Teams
 - Girls scheduled first until we meet 50%
 - Example: Girl's competitive team may be allocated before a recreation team if we haven't reached 50% allocation yet.
 - Girls in Sports Committee





Allocation Priority Criteria

- 1) City programs and activities
- 2) SCHOOLS: Alameda schools with teams that have 75%+ residents. Includes public, private and charter schools.
- 3) ALAMEDA YOUTH REC TEAMS: Non-profit with 75%+ residents with an everyone plays philosophy and generally equal playing time.
- 4) ALAMEDA YOUTH COMP TEAMS: Non-profit with 75+ residents with tryouts and not equal playing time.

NEW! We will schedule by teams/divisions to allocate for recreation and competitive, rather than by league.





Allocation Priority Criteria

- 5) ALAMEDA ADULTS
- 6) FOR-PROFIT SPECIALTY EVENTS ALAMEDA YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS (camps, clinics, tournaments)
- 7) NON-ALAMEDA YOUTH
- 8) NON-ALAMEDA ADULTS





Additional Guidelines/Rules

- Clearly defined payment and cancellation requirements
- No exchange or subleasing of facilities allowed
- Clearly define when fields are not in playable condition
- ARPD's rules and expectations for groups using fields and facilities
- Require users to confirm the organization requires background checks for all adults working with minors (as required by State law)
- Strongly encourage (and provides resources) for concussion protocols and positive coaching







Consequences

- High demand for ARPD athletic facilities and we will hold to the final policy and its requirements.
- FIRST: Written reprimand with corrective measures required SECOND: Loss of Priority Status for next allocation period THIRD: Loss of Priority Status for one year

Examples:

- An organization continues to not provide required documentation (rosters, insurance, etc.)
- An organization sublets
 - Organization grossly and consistently underestimates residency
