






Figure 6: City of Alameda Biotech/Alternative Energy Employment, 3rd Quarter 2010, 2013, 2015, 2017, 2019 and 1st Quarter 2021




Figure 8: Venture Capital Investments in Biotech/Alternative Energy, City of Alameda, 2018-2021 (\$ Millions)
