
Agreement with Friends of the Friends of the Alameda Animal Shelter (FAAS) for Animal Shelter Operations

Amendment to Approved Agreement to Clarify Payment Schedule





Summary

- July 20, 2021: City Council approved a new contract with FAAS to operate the animal shelter for two years, with up to four two-year extensions.
- June 20, 2023: Funds for the animal shelter approved in the FY 23-25 budget not-to-exceed \$2,259,490.
- Tonight: City Council to consider clean-up amendment with the same terms, clarifying the 10-year not-to-exceed compensation \$11,574,639, including an annual escalator based on CPI.
- Annual compensation for FY 25-26 through the remainder of the agreement will be subject to future City Council approval.

- Renovated and reopened the animal shelter with new kennels, flooring, and parking lot
