





Two Agreements, both for 12 months (total of 18 months with two 3-month administrative extensions at City Manager's sole discretion).

License: Continue use of land for temporary performing arts.

ENA: Negotiate exclusively with Little Opera House, Inc. to prepare a draft long term lease with development milestones and potential purchase option.

- Planning Board and Historical Advisory Board review of Development Plan and Architectural Concepts before final City Council consideration.
- City Council Public Hearing to review draft Terms by 9th month.
- City Council public hearing to approve or deny long -term agreements by 12th month.
