ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH VERDE DESIGN TO PROVIDE
DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE ESTUARY PARK RENOVATION, IN AN
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$174,145

WHEREAS, Estuary Park is eight acres located on Mosley Avenue near Singleton Avenue. The park's baseball field and soccer field were previously used by the U.S. Navy and Coast Guard. The park and athletic fields have lain dormant for many years and have fallen into an unusable state of disrepair; and

WHEREAS, the proposed renovation includes a youth baseball field, a lighted synthetic turf rectangular athletic field, playground, park lighting, pathways, pre-fabricated restroom building, landscape and group picnic areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alameda issued a Request for Qualifications to secure a firm able to provide landscape design services and Verde Design was selected after a comprehensive process; and

WHEREAS, funds for the Estuary Park construction will come from a variety of sources including donations and Measure WW.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council approves an agreement with Verde Design to provide design services for the Estuary Park Renovation in an amount not to exceed \$174,145.
