

I object to Walgreens application to get an alcohol, beer and wine permit. At this time, there are 6 stores that carry beer and wine within 2 blocks. I think it doesn't make sense to have stores that sell alcohol on every block and every corner. And also, a lot of neighbors do not want Walgreens to carry alcohol. Walgreens is mainly a pharmacy. Walgreens already has 2 stores within one half mile from the new Walgreens in Alameda. I think that's enough. I've heard in Oakland city there is a limitation of distance within 2 blocks to get a permit. When ABC and the city give alcohol, beer, and wine permit to the applicant, ABC and the city should have a distance limit like the city of Oakland. ABC and the city should give small stores a chance to make a living.
