

## **Sunshine Ordinance Declaration Alameda Municipal Code §2-93.5**

All City employees and officials required to file a Statement of Economic Interests (also known as the Fair Political Practices Commission Form 700) must annually declare that they have read the Sunshine Ordinance and have attended, or will attend when next offered, a training session on the Sunshine Ordinance. A filer who assumes office must file this form within 30 days of the date that he or she is sworn in or assumes employment. The completed declarations are public records.
