- Base Realignment and Closure Round 1993
- Community Reuse Plan 1996
- NAS Alameda Closure 1997
- No-Cost Conveyance Agreement with Navy 2000
- For-Cost Conveyance Negotiations with Master Developers
 2000-2010
- Resurrected No-Cost Conveyance Agreement 2011
- Phase 1 Alameda Point Property Conveyance Completed – 2013
- Closing of Phase 2 Alameda Point Property 2016



Conveyance Package


- Deeds Transfer of Ownership from Navy to City of Alameda
 - 11 Parcels
 - 11 Deeds
 - Minimize uncertainty regarding environmental condition of the property
- Covenants Restricting Use of Property
 - 3 Marsh Crust CRUPs consistent with existing Marsh Crust Ordinance
 - 1 Petroleum CRUP for a closed petroleum site on Northwest Territories
- Bills of Sale Transfer of Ownership of Utility Systems
 - Phase 2 for personal property, storm water and sewer
- Amendment to Lease in Furtherance of Conveyance (LIFOC)
 - Update LIFOC with appropriate building numbers



Conveyance Phases


Four Phases


Phase 2 Conveyance

- 183 Acres Total
 - 37 Acres of Land
 - 146 Acres of Submerged Property
- 11 Parcels



Areas with Land Use Restrictions

- 2 Acres of Land
- 110 Acres of Submerged Land
- Consistent with Land Use Plans
