To whom it may concern,

This is regarding commercial properties owned by The Goode Family Trust. I have maintained a business license for the city of Alameda for approximately 30 years. I recently sold my company however maintained a business license under Ron Goode Motors.

About a year ago I received a renewal for a business license at 1801 Park Street, renter Diamond Auto. This is the first notice I have received for a business license at this property since I sold my company, Ron Goode Toyota. I brought in my current business license for Ron Goode Motors and was told that it was sufficient.

This year I received another notice regarding 1801 Park Street, Diamond Auto and did not respond to it in the proper time frame. After bringing in my license for Ron Goode Motors I was informed that it would not cover the property. In fact, I was informed that I needed other business licenses for commercial properties I owned in Alameda. As of now I have brought current all licenses for all commercial properties back 3 years. I am asking your consideration for the penalties that I'm being asked to pay on properties that I did not know my business license would not cover.

Lack of knowledge of the current laws is not an excuse. However, I have learned only this month that I needed licenses on all commercial properties that are rented. Having brought current all properties for the last three years, I am asking to have all penalties for all properties waived.

Again, for the past 30 years my single business license has always been sufficient for all commercial properties I owned in Alameda.
