- Completed connecting to the CENIC Broadband Backbone at all three libraries –
   Resulting in 54,056 WiFi sessions and 39,528 log-ons to desktop workstations
- Hosted Author Gene Luen Yang, who is the National Ambassador for Young People's Literature









- Total Registered Library Card Holders: 63,025 (14,284 children; 48,741 adults)
- Library Visitors over 450,000
- Annual Check-Outs, including eBooks over 460,000
- Programs presented over 1,000 programs with over 20,000 attendees!
- Almost 61,000 Reference questions answered
- Over 470 visits to the Homebound, delivering over 2,650 items
- Alameda Reads: Adult Literacy program had 453 Learners, ALL reaching their goals!


Over 1,000 programs presented with over 20,000 attendees!


