

Phase Zero – Year 2 Activity Plan

Place Making Activities/Container Village -

The need for a long term home for Phase Zero activities was recognized early on in the project and included as part of the original activity plan in September, 2015 as the Container Café. Place making provides the essential basic infrastructure, "place" for traffic to grow organically, events to have a more lasting impact, and highlights the site's natural assets – stunning views of San Francisco with waterfront access.

Working with Urban Bloc, the team responsible for developing The Yard in San Francisco adjacent to AT&T Park, Q4 2016 will see the unveiling of a new pop-up Container Village at Alameda Point. The project will include a café, beer garden, deck, and flexible games/entertainment area and starting in spring 2017 will have a heavy focus on creating community through regular programming. The Container Village will have regular hours on every weekend starting in April.

Strategically placed adjacent to the Alameda Naval Air Museum the location will enable the project to take advantage of waterfront views, access to power, and avoid Phase One construction. The café & beer garden will be accessible via a temporary route cutting through to the taxiway from W. Tower Ave. with parking located on the taxiway in front of Bladium.

Event Descriptions –

Speer Family Farms Pumpkin Patch – This is the return of the successful pumpkin patch which drew in over 6,000 visitors in 2015. The monthlong event includes multiple inflatable attractions, a petting zoo, and more.

American Armed Forces Cup – This sailing regatta places active members and reservists from all five branches of the military in a competitive challenge to win the trophy. The event will feature the launch of land side





activities with a family friendly afternoon of activities to coincide with the race. Live music, displays from multiple branches of the military will coincide with viewing stands along the shore of Seaplane Lagoon. The event will also serve as a fundraiser for Operation Dignity, a local non-profit providing support services to veterans.



Holiday Photos with Santa – The first activation event to be held within the Container Village the community will be invited to get commemorative photos with Santa. The event will also serve as a toy or canned food drive.

MLK Weekend Coastal Cleanup – A recurring event in which the community is invited to clean up the shores of Alameda Point, followed by an afternoon of refreshments at The Point's Container Village.

Point of Transition Photography Event – This event will be a public showcase of the work from the 30 professional photographers who were invited to document the inside of several buildings within Site A before demolition commenced. The event will also include selected works from an online photography contest.







Alameda Paddle Sports Show – Gear up for summer with a demo day from stand up paddle sports and kayak vendors. The event will give locals the opportunity to get out on the water before the summer winds kick up. Local paddling outrigger canoe, dragon boat, kayak, and stand up paddleboard clubs will be invited to participate.

Container Village Grand Opening – The Container Village is scheduled for a soft launch in Q1 2017 and as the weather heats up and the days get longer the end of April will mark the grand opening and start to the summer season. The occasion will be marked with a community celebration with live music.

Clay Harding Skateboard Tournament – Partnering with Alameda Recreation and Parks Department and Patty Harding, we will work to support a popular and growing tradition in our community with the 3rd annual Clay Harding Skateboard Tournament. Activities at the event

will help benefit park maintenance and improvements.

Outdoor Movies @ **The Point-** As the days get shorter the evenings warm up The Point will be offering an evening outdoor movie complete with special menu options from the café.



Potentially Recurring Events -

These smaller scale events will be hosted within the Container Village and are part of the anticipated regular programming at the site. Should they prove to be successful they will be incorporated in to a recurring calendar of activities.

Yappy Hour – Bring Fido down for a beverage and a cookie at this specially themed dog friendly happy hour at the Container Village.



HOT Yoga @ **The Point** – A recurring event during the summer, The Point's Container Village will host free outdoor yoga.





In Progress -

Burning Man Decompression – This is a highly popular event currently based in San Francisco brings a taste of Burning Man's creative spirit to those who can't make it out to The Playa. Organizers are looking to relocate and expand and see tremendous opportunity to bring big art out to Alameda Point with a free, family friendly street festival. The event currently draws over 10,000 attendees each year.
