The City of Alameda and the City of Alameda Health Care District (COAHCD) Board of Directors Liaison Committee - a Subcommittee of the Alameda City Council - met at City Hall for the purpose of choosing a chair and initiating the liaison process.

Members selected Director Meyers as Liaison Committee Chair. Members agreed to meet quarterly. CAO Panlasigui gave an update on Alameda Hospital operations and the affiliation with the Alameda Health System. It was decided to have a sub-group established to provide review and reporting on the future of Alameda Hospital's physical location and any potential collaboration with the Veteran's Administration medical operations in Alameda. CAO Panlasigui agreed to chair the sub-group and report back at the next meeting.

Director Meyers gave an update on the emerging role of the CoAHCD as a Communitybased Health Care District now that the operations of the Alameda Hospital fall under the responsibility of Alameda Health System. Current areas of focus under consideration are: the provision of care on the island, disaster preparedness and the community's environmental impact on health and well-being. The discussion included staffing, the new community-based health and well-being leadership role of the CoAHCD and CoAHCD oversight of the parcel tax.

There being no further business, Director Meyers adjourned the meeting at 2:05 p.m.
