WHEREAS, in order to recruit experienced lateral police officers from other agencies, the City has developed a recruitment and incentive policy in order to be competitive with other organizations competing for lateral candidates.

NOW, THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City that said Council approve a Recruitment and Incentive Policy for Lateral Police Officers.
