




Oak Tree Protections

- Arborists Report
- City Arborists Review
- Site Visits by Staff and Planning Board to inspect root system
- Pier Foundation (avoid roots, avoid compaction of roots)
- Drainage (protect trees)
- Adjusted Driveway Access
- Maintained existing setback from rear property line.

- Applicant has done everything right.
